

## TEN-YEAR REVIEW OF HYPOSPADIAS SURGERY FROM A SINGLE CENTRE

**Objective** To evaluate the outcome of a universal technique for repair of hypospadias in one centre over a period of Ten Years

**Design** Descriptive study.

**Place and Duration of Study** Plastic Surgery Clinic, Aman Hospital Dabgari Gardens, Peshawar and Department of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, Postgraduate Medical Institute Hayatabad Medical Complex Peshawar from January 1994 to December 2003.

**Materials and Methods** Aivar Bracka Technique was used universally for all kinds of hypospadias in two stages. All data was already saved in a computer database and with photographic evidence. This was retrieved and analysed using SPSS10.0.1. Special consideration was given to complications.

**Results** A total of 1206 patients fulfilled the criteria and were included in the study. Our overall fistula rate has been 3.8%. Other complications included repeated UTI (3%) and hair growth in the urethra (0.2%).

**Conclusion** Using a single technique for all grades of hypospadias shortens the learning period. A planned two staged procedure gives far more superior results both functionally and aesthetically than any single stage procedure; the latter usually ends up in unplanned multiple operations.
